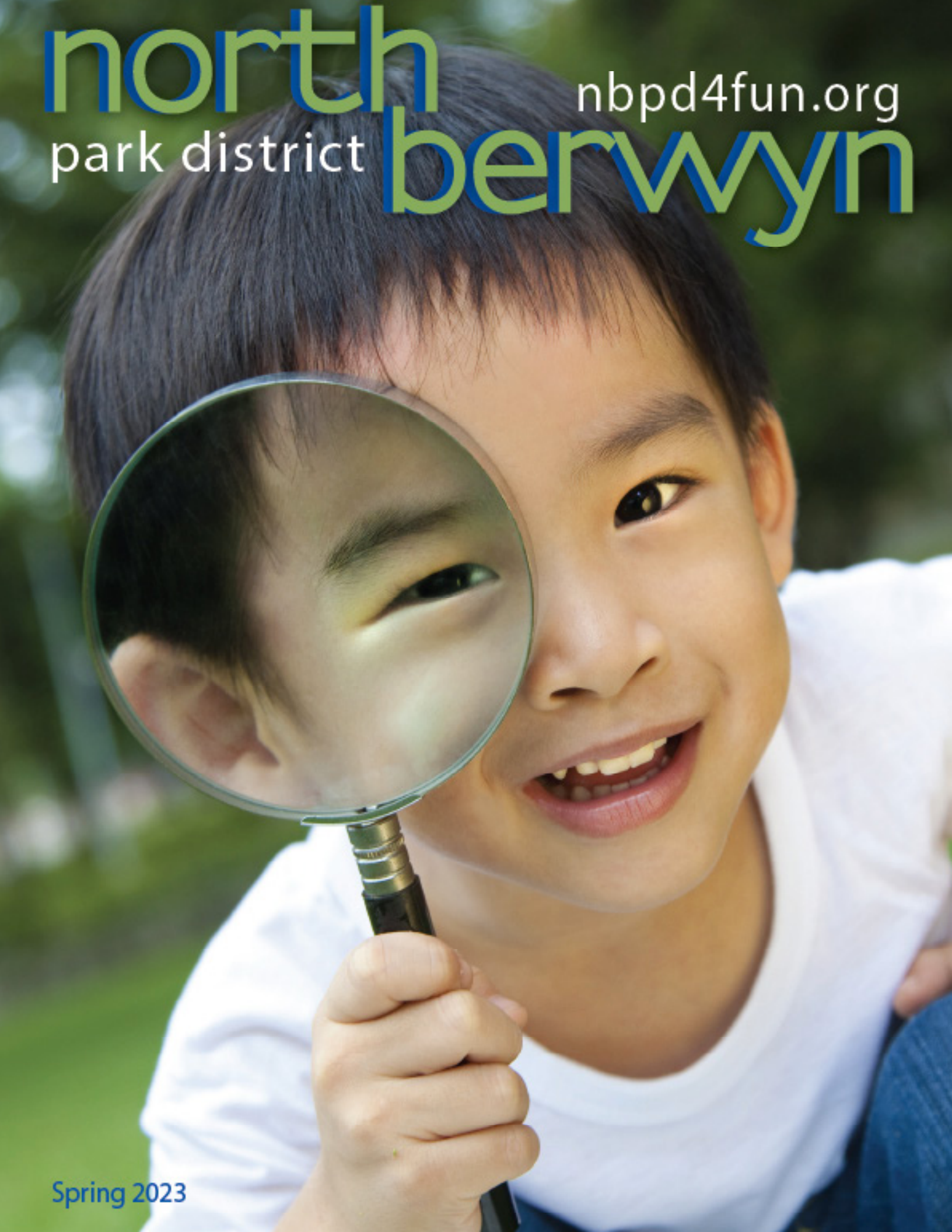


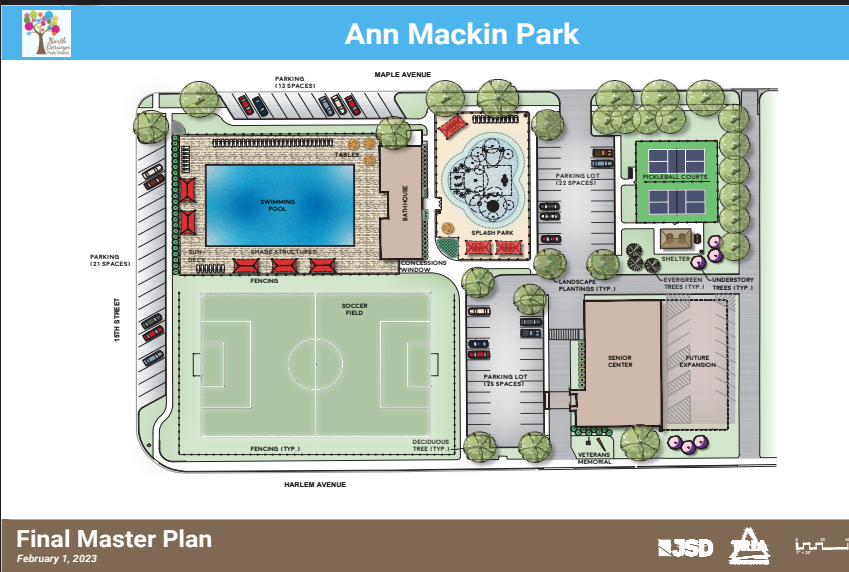

Ann Mackin Park Project

Under the umbrella of **NBPD 2.0** is the **Ann Mackin Park Project** the largest recreational addition to the City of Berwyn in the past 30 years. This project could not have been possible without the support of the North Berwyn voters that approved the only referendum in the history of the North Berwyn Park District!

This project has been developed with the input of the residents that attended community planning meetings and gave their opinion of what the needs are for the community in the future.

Improvements and additions under consideration are

- The 1st dedicated Senior Center in Berwyn
- Deep water pool that would replace the current footprint of the old Maple pool. The facility would provide programs for residents, including swimming lessons, swim team, lap swimming, open swim, senior swim, swim fitness classes, life-guard training and various other swim programs.
- Water Park
- Two pickle ball courts
- Veterans Memorial
- Soccer field
- Future Art Center
- and other leisure and recreational amenities for Berwyn residents of all ages and interests.

These projects would improve virtually every aspect of the district's operations to benefit patrons of all ages.

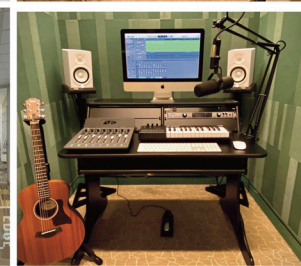
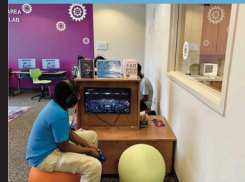

Hello Neighbors!


