# How you can receive **FREE** or Discounted after-school Care & Camp for your child...

The North Berwyn Park District's participation in the Illinois Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) opens the door to quality, affordable child care for working families.

The Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP), funded by the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS), assists low-income working families with paying for child care services. Parents must meet the State of Illinois' income and family size guidelines.

## 1 Determine if You Qualify

The Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) helps parents that are in school or working pay for child care. Eligibility is based on gross income and family size.



**NEW!** Open Studio!

If your hectic schedule has prevented you from committing to our 8 week long classes, then our new drop in open studio hours are perfect for your creative family! Simply purchase a punch card good for 5 visits from our front desk and drop in when the mood strikes. Basic materials for painting and drawing projects will be provided, but participants are welcome to bring materials from home as long as they are non-toxic and do not require specialized ventilation. Please see below for more information.

**Studio Guidelines**

- While this is not an instructor lead class, each Open Studio session will be staffed by park district personnel who will assist the artists with materials and offer advice and guidance as needed.
- Parents of participants under the age of 14 must sign them in and out of the Open Studio program.
- Participants are not allowed to return to the Open Studio session once they have signed out.
- There will be a limit of 1 canvas per visit.
- Each person attending Open Studio hours must register for a 5 visit punch card at the front desk before attending. Punch cards can be used on any session day.
- Open Studio participants are able to store current projects at the studio, finished pieces must be taken home.
- Participants are expected to clean and put away any materials used, and clean up their work space before leaving.
- The park district reserves the right to close Open Studio if participants have not arrived within 45 minutes of session time.

## Refunds & Credits

The North Berwyn Park District will grant refunds/credits for classes/programs as follows:

Prior to the first scheduled meeting.....Total fee  
Before the second scheduled meeting...75% of fee  
Before the third scheduled meeting.....50% of fee  
After the third scheduled meeting.....No refunds/credits

For TRIPS, refunds/credits will not be given after the "Register by" date or unless a replacement can be found.
