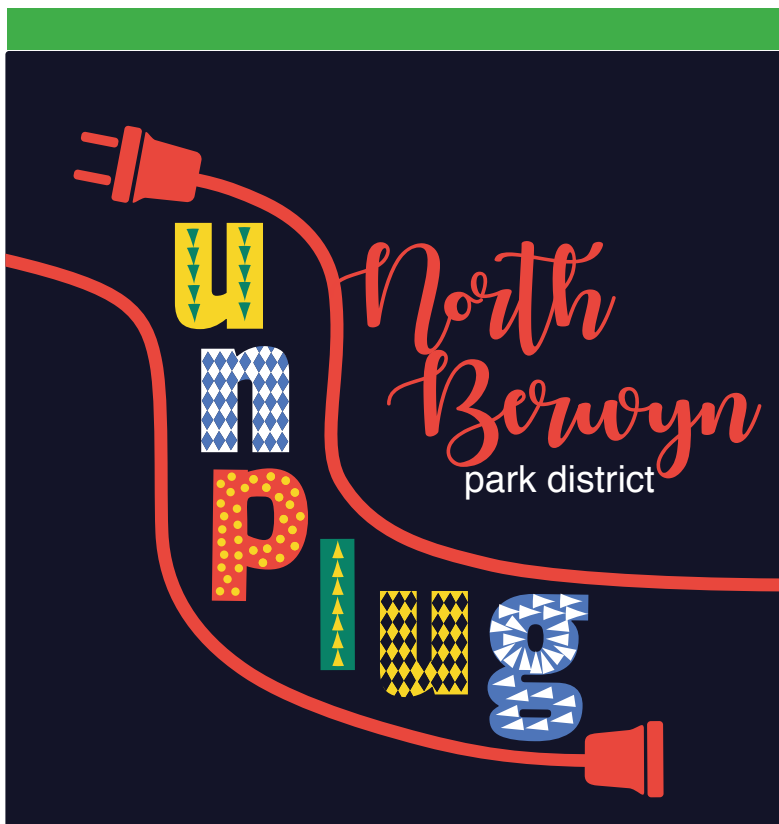

During this past April Election, two new Commissioners were chosen by the voters of North Berwyn to join our North Berwyn Park District Family.

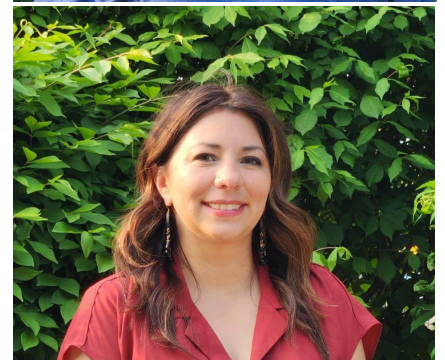
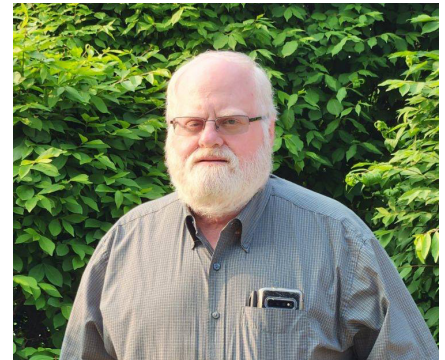
