


## 1) Who is eligible for child care assistance from the state?

- Recipient of Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- Teen parent enrolled full-time in elementary or high school, or GED classes to obtain high school degree or its equivalent
- Family with a Special Needs child(ren)
- Working family whose monthly income does not exceed 50% of the most current Federal Poverty Level for their family size  
(See monthly income levels below)

Within six months of initial child care assistance eligibility, an eligible family with an absent parent must have an active collection case with the Division of Child Support Services at the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. A case must be opened against the absent parent of every child within the family's household.

If a family does not comply with this requirement within the given time frame, the child care case will be canceled
