





Refunds & Credits

The North Berwyn Park District will grant refunds/credits for classes/programs as follows:

Prior to the first scheduled meeting......Total fee Before the second scheduled meeting....75% of fee Before the third scheduled meeting......50% of fee After the third scheduled meeting......No refunds/credits

For TRIPS, refunds/credits will not be given after the "Register by" date or unless a replacement can be found.

Equal Access

Pets


