Make sure you also log into our website to register for our 5th Annual, Corrida del Mariachi 5K.

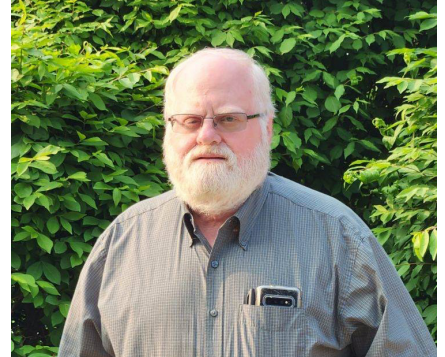
