FEBRUARY 16-18, 2024

Elise Dubois was born in 1936 and experienced the Second World War herself in the Netherlands. Only after the war did she learn about the fate her mother's family had met in the concentration camps in Germany and Poland.

After intensive research and with much support from the people around her, she wrote The Missing Stories. These are the stories her mother could never tell her because her mouth could not form the words.

This one man show tells us about the lives of three generations of Elise's family. Their hardships and their deaths; as well as their survival and their lives, with the experience and the knowledge of their history.


