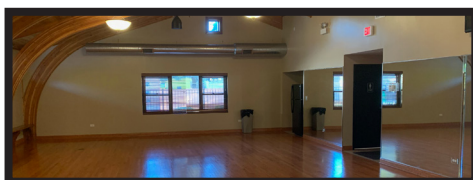

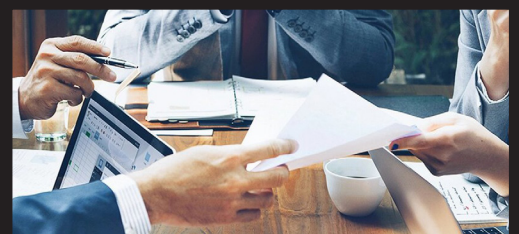
As you look through our Winter Brochure, I hope you find something new, exciting, or meaningful that you'll want to explore with us in the coming season.
