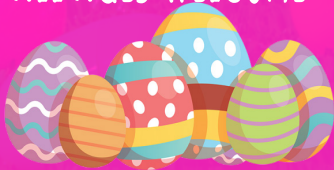


On behalf of the Board of Commissioners and the entire staff at the North Berwyn Park District, we would like to wish everyone a safe and Happy 2022 from our family to yours.
